## <u>Cultural Corner</u>

Hmong New Year is an **annual celebration** that takes place in December to honor the ancestors and spirits and give thanks for the completion of the year's harvest as well as to welcome in a new beginning. The celebration is rooted in agricultural history and religious tradition, and can range from 3 days to a week long. Hmong New Year is referred to as Tsiab Peb Caug (New 30) or Noj Peb Caug (Eat 30) because traditionally, Hmong people would prepare many meals over the course of 30 days to celebrate the new year.
